Discovery Bay Golf Club Congratulates Home-Grown Golfer Taichi Kho in Finishing Runner-up in Asia-Pacific Amateur Championship

HONG KONG (6 December 2021) – A lot of people used to dream big when they were young but not too many would diligently take action to realise it. This is not the case for home-grown golfer Taichi Kho hailing from Discovery Bay Golf Club (DBGC), who finished second in the 12th Asia-Pacific Amateur Championship held in Dubai earlier.

Taichi has been practising golf at DBGC since the age of 5, following his father Victor Kho's footsteps, and set his goal to be the world number 1 when he was 6. Even at an early age, he showed keen interest, passion and talent on golfing. Under the guidance of his father and other DBGC coaches, Taichi refined his skills in the Club's challenging golf courses before joining Hong Kong Golf Association team and college team. The father and son duo have treated DBGC as their home course and could always be seen swinging their clubs on tee.

As the captain of the DBGC Men's Team, Victor is obviously proud of his son's achievement. He commented, "Taichi used to go to driving range almost every day when he finished school, regardless the weather conditions. Living in Discovery Bay and being a member of DBGC have provided the convenience for him to do what he loves to do. DBGC has a beautiful golf course and is a great community to spend time in. We received a lot of support from staff and fellow golfers which helped grow Taichi's interest in golfing."

Being the runner-up of this year's Asia-Pacific Amateur Championship, Taichi will now be the first Hong Kong athlete to play in the Qualifying Series of The Open. Mr Eddie Chan, General Manager of DBGC, said, "We congratulate Taichi's achievement. DBGC has long been dedicated to nurturing young and talented golfers. Back in 2005, DBGC made an exception in allowing Taichi, aged 5 at that time, to start playing before reaching the minimum playing age of 10. Taichi's outstanding performance on the international stage gives us great encouragement and recognises our effort in grooming youngsters."

As part of the juniors nurturing programme, DBGC introduced innovative modality and approaches for junior golf academy in 2008 and adjusted the minimum age for on-course playing right from 10 to 6 in 2010.

Other than providing support to his son and leading the DBGC Men's Team, Victor is also a champion of junior golfing. He coordinates the DBGC elite juniors practice every week, which is supported by the Club's special allocation of tee time for this purpose. DBGC also has a junior clinic in place led by our Golf Pro.

"Taichi always has a big ambition of being the best in the golfing world and he is working hard towards this goal. We are glad to have received support from the management and staff from DBGC, and allowed Taichi to become the youngest member at that time. I would very much

like to do the same to support other junior golfers and help them realise that they all have potential to reach their goals.” Victor said. In this regard, Eddie added, “We are pleased to have Victor to help promote golfing among juniors. More promising juniors have already been identified and we at the DBGC will provide all possible support to groom these young talents. We look forward to seeing more young golf stars in the years to come.”
